

**COUNCIL FOR ANTHROPOPHICAL HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE
(LEGAL ASSESSORS) RULES 2006**

The Council for Anthroposophical Health and Social Care hereby make the following Rules:-

Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the Council for Anthroposophical Health and Social Care (Legal Assessors) Rules 2006 and shall come into force on 3rd July 2006.

Interpretation

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires-
- "the Committee" means the Investigating Committee, the Professional Conduct Committee, or the Health Committee as the case may be;
 - "Legal Assessor" means a Legal Assessor appointed by the Council;
 - "the Council" means the Council for Anthroposophical Health and Social Care;
 - "registrant" means a person registered with the Council for Anthroposophical Health and Social Care, and includes a person whose registration is currently suspended

Additional Functions

3. A Legal Assessor shall have the following additional functions-
- (a) to give advice to the Council on questions of law arising in connection with any matter which the Council is considering;
 - (b) to be present at such meetings of the Committee as the Committee may request at which an allegation against a registrant is being considered and to advise on any questions of law arising which may be referred to him by the Committee;
 - (c) to inform the Council or the Committee forthwith of any irregularity in the Council's or the Committee's consideration of any complaint or in the conduct of any proceedings before the Council or the Committee which may come to his knowledge and to advise it of his own motion where it appears to him that but for such advice, there is a possibility of a mistake of law being made;
 - (d) to be present at such meetings of the Council as the Council may require at which an appeal under Rules of the Council is being considered, to advise on any question of law arising which may be referred to him by the Council and to question any witness giving evidence at an oral hearing of such an appeal.
