

**COUNCIL FOR ANTHROPOSOPHICAL HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE
(RECOGNITION OF QUALIFICATIONS) RULES 2006**

The Council for Anthroposophical Health and Social Care hereby make the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Council for Anthroposophical Health and Social Care (Recognition of Qualification) Rules 2000 and shall come into force on 3rd July 2006.

Interpretation

2. In these Rules
- “the Council” means the Council for Anthroposophical Health and Social Care;
 - “the Committee” means the Education Committee established by the Council;
 - “registrant” means a person registered with the Council for Anthroposophical Health and Social Care.

Statement of the Education Committee

3. The Committee shall publish a statement, and may from time to time amend the statement, indicating
- (a) matters on which the Committee will wish to be satisfied before advising the Council to recognise a qualification; and
 - (b) matters which may cause the Committee to advise the Council not to recognise a qualification.

Non-United Kingdom Qualifications

4. A person who
- (a) has obtained a qualification outside the United Kingdom;
 - (b) does not hold a recognised qualification; but
 - (c) satisfies the Registrar that he has reached the required standard of proficiency

shall be treated as holding a recognised qualification.
